## **9th Sunday after Pentecost**

**The Forefeast of the Transfiguration of our Lord. Holy Martyr Eusignius of Antioch - Dormition Fast. Food with Oil. Tone 8. 1 Cor 15:12-19, Matt. 21:18-22.**

**Troparion of the Resurrection - Tone 8:** You descended from on high, O Merciful One. You accepted the three-day burial to free us from our passions. Our Live and Resurrection; O Lord, Glory to You.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

**Kontakion of the Resurrection - Tone 8:** Having risen from the tomb, You raised the dead and resurrected Adam. Eve rejoices in Your Resurrection and the ends of the earth celebrate Your Rising from the dead, O Greatly Merciful One.

Both now, and ever, and unto the ages of ages. Amen.

**Theotokion - Tone 8:** You who were born of a Virgin for our sake and suffered crucifixion, O Good One, destroyed death by death, and revealed the Resurrection as God. Despise not the work of Your hands O Merciful One, and manifest Your love for mankind. Hear the Theotokos, Your mother who prays for us, and save us, O our Saviour, a despairing people.

**Prokeimenon - Tone 8 (Psalm 75:11, 1):** Pray and give glory to the Lord our God.

**Verse:** In Judah God is known; His name is great in Israel.

**Alleluia - Tone 8 (Psalm 94:1, 2):** Come let us rejoice in the Lord. Let us shout with joy to God our Saviour.

**Verse:** Let us come before His face with thanksgiving, and with psalms let us shout with joy to Him.

**1 Cor 3: 9-17 -**

Brethren! we are God's servants, working together; you are God's field, God's building. According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building on it. Each builder must choose with care how to build on it. For no one can lay any foundation other than the one that has been laid; that foundation is Jesus Christ. Now if anyone builds on the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw— the work of each builder will become visible, for the Day will disclose it, because it will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test what sort of work each has done. If what has been built on the foundation survives, the builder will receive a reward. If the work is burned, the builder will suffer loss; the builder will be saved, but only as through fire. Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you? If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple.

**Alleluia – Tone 7:** It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing unto Your Name, O Most High.

**Verse:** To proclaim Your mercy in the morning and Your truth by night.

**Matt. 14:22-34**

At that time, Jesus, made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. And after he had dismissed the crowds, he went up the mountain by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone, but by this time the boat, battered by the waves, was far from the land, for the wind was against them. And early in the morning he came walking towards them on the lake. But when the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified, saying, 'It is a ghost!' And they cried out in fear. But immediately Jesus spoke to them and said, 'Take heart, it is I; do not be afraid.' Peter answered him, 'Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water.' He said, 'Come.' So Peter got out of the boat, started walking on the water, and came towards Jesus. But when he noticed the strong wind, [b] he became frightened, and beginning to sink, he cried out, 'Lord, save me!' Jesus immediately reached out his hand and caught him, saying to him, 'You of little faith, why did you doubt?' When they got into the boat, the wind ceased. And those in the boat worshipped him, saying, 'Truly you are the Son of God.' When they had crossed over, they came to land at Gennesaret.

**Communion Verse:** Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.
