## **10th Sunday after Pentecost**

**Martyrs Anicletus & Photius & many with them (305-306). Heiromartyr Alexander, bp. of Colmana (III). Martyrs Pamphilus & Capito - Dormition Fast. Food with Oil. Tone 1. 1 Cor 4:9-16, Matt. 17:14-23.**

**Troparion of the Resurrection - Tone 1:** When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, and the soldiers were guarding Your most pure Body, You arose on the third day, O Saviour, granting life to the world. Therefore, the powers of heaven cried out to You, O Giver of life: Glory to Your Resurrection, O Christ. Glory to Your kingdom. Glory to Your providence, O only Lover of mankind.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

**Kontakion of the Resurrection - Tone 1:** As God, You arose from the tomb in glory, raising the world together with Yourself. Human nature praises You as God, for death has vanished. Adam exults, O Master; Eve rejoices, for she is freed from bondage and cries out: You, O Christ, are the One who gives resurrection to all.

Both now, and ever, and unto the ages of ages. Amen.

**Theotokion - Tone 1:** When Gabriel cried out to You O Virgin: Rejoice! The Master of all became incarnate in You, the holy Tabernacle. Thus, the words of the righteous David were fulfilled; in bearing Your Creator, You have revealed Yourself as more spacious than the

heavens. Therefore, we cry out to You: Glory to the One who dwelt in You. Glory to the One who came forth from You. Glory to the One who set us free through Your birth-giving.

**Prokeimenon - Tone 1 (Psalm 32:22, 1):** Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us as we have put our hope in You.

**Verse:** Rejoice in the Lord, you righteous. Praise befits the upright.

**1 Cor 4: 9-16 -**

Brethren! I think that God has exhibited us apostles as last of all, as though sentenced to death, because we have become a spectacle to the world, to angels and to mortals. We are fools for the sake of Christ, but you are wise in Christ. We are weak, but you are strong. You are held in honour, but we in disrepute. To the present hour we are hungry and thirsty, we are poorly clothed and beaten and homeless, and we grow weary from the work of our own hands. When reviled, we bless; when persecuted, we endure; when slandered, we speak kindly. We have become like the rubbish of the world, the dregs of all things, to this very day. I am not writing this to make you ashamed, but to admonish you as my beloved children. For though you might have ten thousand guardians in Christ, you do not have many fathers. Indeed, in Christ Jesus I became your father through the gospel. I appeal to you, then, be imitators of me.

**Alleluia - Tone 1 (Psalm 17:47, 50):** God avenges me, and has subdued peoples under me.

**Verse:** He magnifies the salvation of the king and deals mercifully for His anointed, for David and for his seed forever.

**Matt. 17:14-23**

At that time, they came to the crowd, a man came to him, knelt before him, and said, ‘Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and he suffers terribly; he often falls into the fire and often into the water. And I brought him to your disciples, but they could not cure him.’ Jesus answered, ‘You faithless and perverse generation, how much longer must I be with you? How much longer must I put up with you? Bring him here to me.’ And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him, and the boy was cured instantly. Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, ‘Why could we not cast it out?’ He said to them, ‘Because of your little faith. For truly I tell you, if you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, “Move from here to there”, and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you.’ As they were gathering in Galilee, Jesus said to them, ‘The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into human hands, and they will kill him, and on the third day he will be raised.’ And they were greatly distressed.

**Communion Verse:** Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.
