

## **7th Sunday after Pentecost**

**Holy Myrrh-bearer and Equal to the Apostles  
Mary Magdalene. Tone 6. Rom. 15:1-7, Matt.  
9:27-35.**

**Tropar of the Resurrection – Tone 6:** The angelic powers were at Your tomb; and the guards became as dead men; and Mary stood by Your grave seeking Your Most Pure Body. You captured hades, not being tempted by it; You came to the Virgin, granting life. O Lord, Who arose from the dead, glory to You.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit. Both now, and ever, and unto the ages of ages. Amen.

**Kontakion of the Resurrection - Tone 6:** When Christ God, the Giver of Life, raised all of the dead from the valley of sorrow with His mighty hand, He bestowed resurrection on the human race. He is the Saviour of all, the Resurrection, the Life, and the God of all.

**Prokeimenon - Tone 6:** Save, O Lord, thy people; and bless Your inheritance.

**Verse:** To You, O Lord, have I cried; o my God, be not silent unto me.

**Rom. 15: 1-7 -**

Brethren! We who are strong ought to put up with the failings of the weak, and not to please ourselves. Each of us must please our neighbour for the good purpose of building up the neighbour. For Christ did not please himself; but, as it is written, 'The insults of those who insult you have fallen on me.' For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, so that by steadfastness and by the encouragement of the scriptures we might have hope. May the God of steadfastness and encouragement grant you to live in harmony with one another, in accordance with Christ Jesus, so that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Welcome one another, therefore, just as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God.

**Alleluia – Tone 6:** It is good to praise the Lord, and to sing unto Your Name, O Most High.

**Verse:** To proclaim Your mercy in the morning and Your truth by night.

**Matt. 9:27-35**

At that time, Jesus went on from there, two blind men followed him, crying loudly, 'Have mercy on us, Son of David!' When he entered the house, the blind men came to him; and Jesus said to them, 'Do you believe that I am able to do this?' They said to him, 'Yes, Lord.' Then he touched their eyes and said, 'According to your faith let it be done to you.' And their eyes were opened. Then

Jesus sternly ordered them, 'See that no one knows of this.' But they went away and spread the news about him throughout that district. After they had gone away, a demoniac who was mute was brought to him. And when the demon had been cast out, the one who had been mute spoke; and the crowds were amazed and said, 'Never has anything like this been seen in Israel.' But the Pharisees said, 'By the ruler of the demons he casts out the demons.' Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, and curing every disease and every sickness.

**Communion Verse:** Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.
