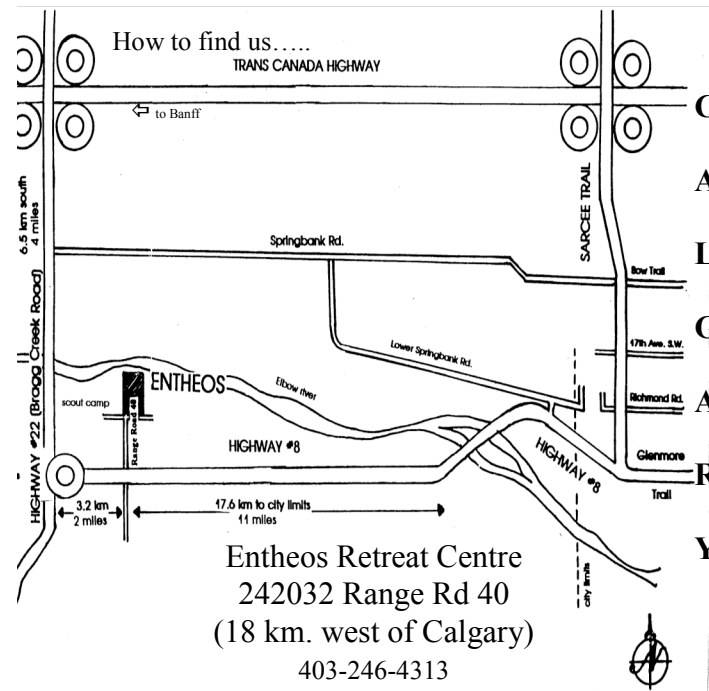

Come and join us!

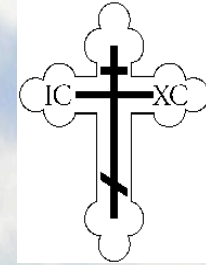

Guest Speaker: Fr. David Hovik has been the priest at St. Andrew Orthodox Church in Arlington, WA since February of 1997. He was an Evangelical Protestant pastor for over 19 years prior to leading his parish through the 6 1/2-year process of converting from Evangelical Protestantism to the Orthodox Church. Making the journey with him were 33 families and St. Andrew has since grown to 70 families.

He has been married for 38 years to Presb. Debbie and they have 4 children and 10 grandchildren. Their entire family converted to the Orthodox faith and are active at St. Andrew.

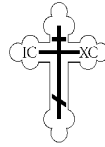
